

# Example Applications



## Pass Query String Parameters


This example demonstrates how to pass data into a new instance via a query string, part of an app instance's uniform resource locator ('URL').

A query string will include a parameter name and a corresponding parameter value. For example:

name=Roberta%20Chang

In this example, the parameter name is 'name,' and the parameter value is "Roberta%20Chang' (where '%20' is the URL encoding reference for space since URLs may not contain spaces.)

Check the logic on the *App is Opened* behavior event.



1: Two **Set Field** commands are used with the Get URL Parameter function to import the data from the URL query string for the *name* & *color* parameters; this is the crucial part of the example.

2: A **Set Field** command is used to convert the color to upper case for consistency and to allow the logic at step 3 to work correctly.

3: Various **Set Field** or **Set State** commands are used after a **Multiple Branch** command to manage the color chosen. If either red, blue or green is passed via the parameter value, then the corresponding radio button is checked; otherwise, any other color is placed into a separate field.
